

Greetings OSA Families,

In accordance with our commitment to provide safe after school care for our students we will continue to offer our Aftercare program for the 19-20 school year. Aftercare provides a safe and supervised environment for students to complete homework, play games, and socialize with friends. The program will officially begin on the first day of school (Monday, August 19th) under the supervision of Mr. Denmark and will meet in the student center on M, T, Th, F from 3:15 - 5:00 and Wednesdays from 1:00-5:00. The cost to families will be a daily flat rate of \$10 for families that pay in advance or a \$20 drop in flat rate. The daily fee will be waived for families that qualify and sign up for our free and reduced lunch program. This is the lowest cost we can offer to families while keeping the program sustainable. Advanced payments can be made by cash or check and the program coordinator will alert families when the account balance reaches \$30 or less. Students that are enrolled in the program will have this denoted in their class schedule on Powerschool, giving families the ability to monitor their student's after school attendance.

If you are interested in signing up for the after school program, please print and fill out the attached form and have dropped to the front office (to be placed in Mr. Denmark's box) or have your student bring it with them to the Aftercare program. Advanced payments can be made by cash or check (made out to OSA with "Aftercare" on the memo line) and included with the form. .

OSA After School Program Registration Form

OSA's after school program will operate in the student center from 1:0pm-5:00pm on Wednesdays and 3:15pm-5:00pm on M, Tu, Th, and Friday. The program will be supervised by OSA employee Mr. Denmark. In order to ensure that this program is organized, safe, and effective it is critical that all students and families adhere to the agreements below:

Please look review following agreements then sign and turn in to the main office:

1. Students must be on time to participate in the program (3:25 for middle school students and 4:25 for high school students). Late students will be charged the daily drop-in rate of \$20. Parents/guardians will be notified if this happens.
2. Once a student has accrued a \$60 balance from drop-in charges, the student will not be permitted to attend the after school program until the balance has been paid. The program coordinator will inform families of any outstanding balance the day of the drop-in charge.
3. Students will only be released from the program when parents/guardians arrive or if given explicit permission for early release from parents/guardians in advance.
4. All students are expected to act in accordance with OSA behavioral expectations as outlined in the student handbook in addition to any expectations outline by the program coordinator. Parents/guardians will be contacted if a student does not meet the behavioral expectations of the program. Upon third contact, the student will not be permitted to participate in the program for a two week period.
5. This program is only sustainable with an average minimum of 10 daily participants. If this program becomes unsustainable, it may result in its cancellation. If cancelled, OSA will provide at least one week notice prior to the final day the program will be offered.
